



## **Updated Patient Mapping Requirements**

Applicants or Current Participants who are testing or will be entering testing in the Developers Integration Lab (DIL) under the Participant and/or Product Testing Programs led by Healtheway on behalf of the eHealth Exchange will be required to perform the following additional steps highlighted in the sections below:

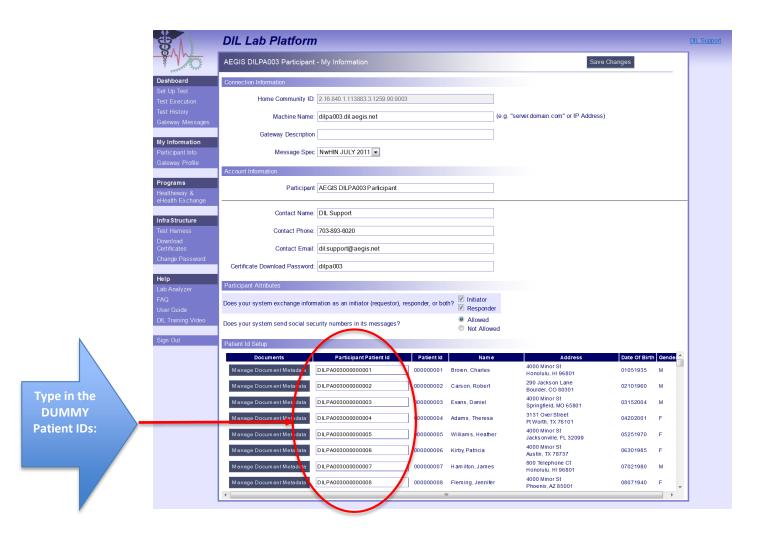
1. Once logged into DIL environment navigate to the Dashboard screen. Under My Information on the left side of the screen select "Participant Info". See below:







- 2. If you are an **APPLICANT OR PARTICIPANT** that is testing or about to begin testing in the DIL, you will need to do the following:
  - a. After selecting Participant Info you will be taken to the below screen. You will need to scroll down to the bottom of this screen and map patient IDs as required from your System Under Test (SUT).
  - b. Applicants or Participants in the Participant Testing Program should map for the 12 required test patients as shown in the updated (eHealth Exchange Participant Testing Data Load Set-DS\_PRL-2.xls tab #2) and you can then use the dummy numbers provided in the that tab (DP0001 DP0022) to complete the mapping to allow you to run all tests in the service set. These tests will not be reviewed or reported on for the Participant Testing Program.
  - c. Note: If you do not map the additional patients, you will get an error when you try to run tests, indicating patient must be mapped.







- 3. If you are a **PRODUCT VENDOR** that is currently testing or about to begin testing in the DIL, you will need to do the following:
  - a. After selecting Participant Info you will be taken to the below screen. You will need to scroll down to the bottom of this screen and map patient IDs as required from your System Under Test (SUT).
  - b. Product Vendors will be required to map all 34 patient ID's for their SUT as shown in the updated (eHealth\_Exchange\_Participant Testing\_Data\_Load\_Set-DS\_PRL-2.xls tab #3).
