

Background: eHealth Exchange Content Testing

- No Content Testing Required: If Participant or Vendor's architecture is certified for MU 2011 editon or 2014 edition
- If not MU certified: Required to test one or more of the following:
 - The Basic C32 (ONC 2011 Edition)
 - The Bridge C32
 - The Consolidated CDA (C-CDA) (ONC 2014 Edition)
- June 2015 Coordinating Committee -Not Good Enough
 - Needs Improvement
- Approves Launch of Testing Workgroup
 - Initial Focus on Content Testing

Why should organizations participate in the Content Testing Pilot?

Value-add for Participants of the Content Testing Pilot:

- Participants will learn how well they comply to future content testing requirements
- Pilot participants will receive a free testing report and scorecard 3.
- Participants can leverage free education for the HL7 standards leveraged by Sequoia Staff
- 5. Participants can increase the amount of data that can be exchanged with partners and improve the clinical content of the discrete data exchanged
- Participants will be empowered to provide feedback on production testing requirements and scores in collaboration with **HL7** for inclusion in future documentation:
 - Improved Scorecard Rubrics
 - Future HL7 C-CDA Companion Guide
- All the above will be **FREE** value adds during the Content Testing Pilot

2. Pilot Content Testing Program will cover HL7 C-CDA CCD r1.1 and r2.1 with an overlay of the 2015 Meaningful Use requirements during the trial period through June 2016.

The Implementation FAQ's/Pain Points being tracked will continue to be reviewed by the Testing Workgroup Committee members and lessons learned will be Document coordinated with HL7 efforts to improve specifications and the pilot content testing documentation.
