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





Q&A Review from 10/29/2020 Meeting

- 1. This workgroup falls under the Interoperability Matters Forum and is separate from the RCE and TEFCA efforts, but could inform those efforts if appropriate
- 2. Existing implementation guides, scorecard rubrics and Implementation Guides from other work efforts such as Carequality/Commonwell, Argonaut, DaVinci or SDO's such as IHE or HL7 will always be considered
- 3. Focus on Information exchanged between systems to enable semantic interoperability
 - Can include data from Data Aggregators, EHRs, Labs (LIS), Radiology (RIS), Pharmacy, etc.
 - Can include guidance for data aggregators who transform data
 - All systems can be considered in implementation guidance workgroup will make determination of systems specifics
 - Can include guidance on data captured at the source "front-end data"
 - Focus on data elements/attributes transport agnostic (C-CDA or FHIR)
 - Focus should be on bi-directional exchange priorities
